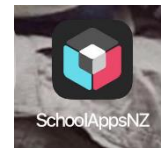


This week's joke: What's a mermaid?

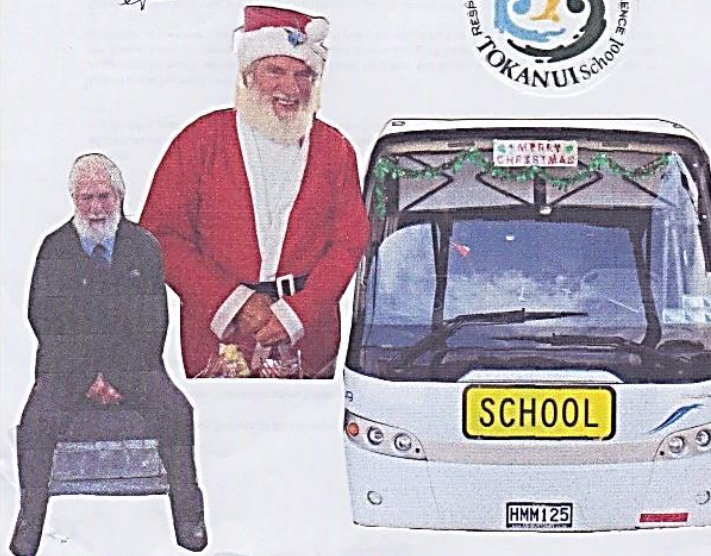
