



### Tena koutou katoa

Term three is here and with a bit of a difference as we start with our new daily times. School now starts at 8:45am and the day ends for the children at 2:30pm with buses running 15 minutes earlier in the mornings and 30 minutes earlier in the afternoons. This is a trial and later in the year we will survey families to see how they find it. A number of schools around Southland have been doing this successfully for many years, for a variety of reasons. I am interested in what ways it helps your family and anything that it has made difficult. Initially there will be some adjustments that we will have to navigate. In the meantime, thank you for supporting the school to make this work. The reason for this change is to improve our tamariki attending school so please make appointments and out of school commitments outside of school hours. "Regular attendance is defined for statistical purposes as 90% attendance or higher. However, Ministry analysis shows there is no 'safe' level of non-attendance; every day matters. Every day at school has a cumulative impact on students' learning. A child with an average of 90% attendance will miss the equivalent of one year of schooling in ten." Ministry of Education.

Each term we send the Advocate newspaper some stories and pictures showing what the children of Tokanui School have been up to. You may have noticed that the paper form of this is currently suspended. Thank you for the support with the Cross Country that the senior students ran at school at the end of last term. This was a very successful event that was well run by our seniors. The best learning occurs when our children are in control of something that they are passionate about and they use their competencies to bring it all together. I was so impressed with Marc and Mackenzy who used their initiative and measured out the course using Google Maps. The students all experimented with how to make the colour for the colour run which proved to be a lot of fun. It was a lovely atmosphere and awesome to have so many from the community supporting this.
