

Kia ora everyone

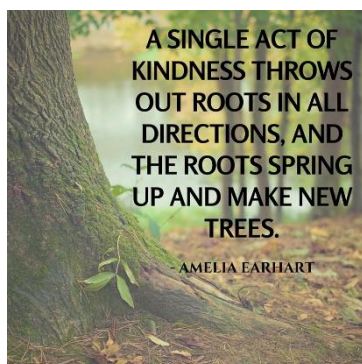

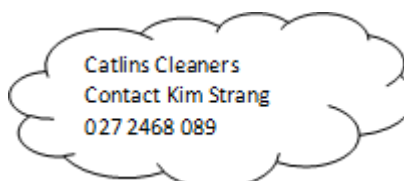
Have a pint and save a life!

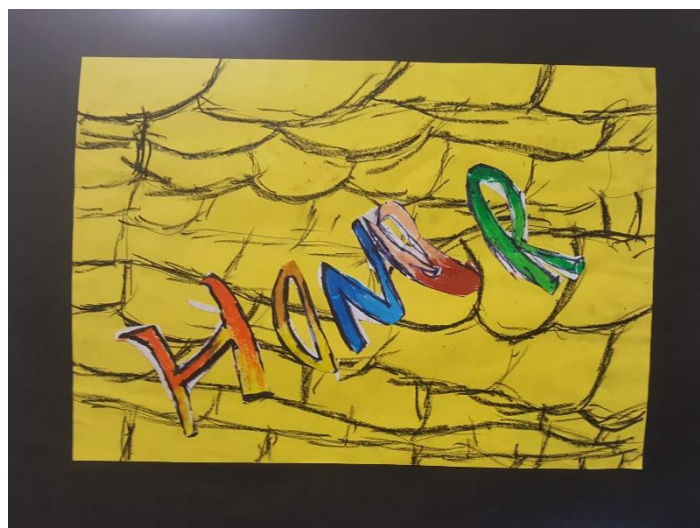
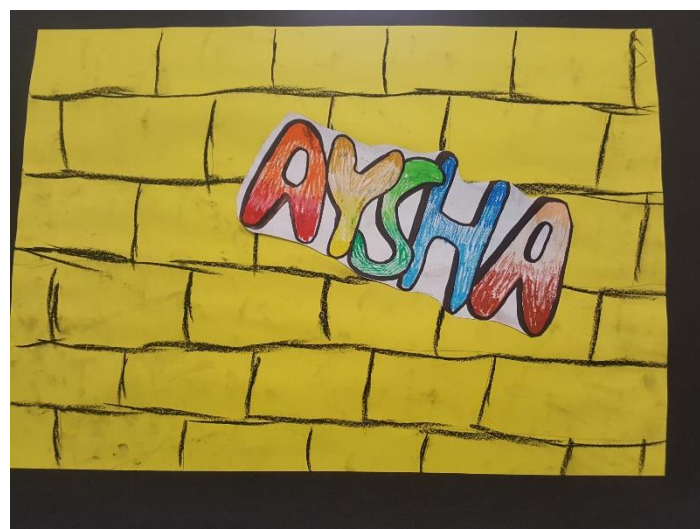


Rugby Southland are holding Six Girls Rugby Nights across Southland.
