Kia ora everyone

It was so good to see so many from our community supporting our Pet Day once again. This is such a good time to all get together after the busy weeks of lambing and calving and we do appreciate the support from our wider community. The children love sharing their pets with their classmates and they make it very difficult for Mrs Poole and I judging the fancy-dress with their very clever costumes. It was nice to have our two Learning Support Coordinators helping us with this on Friday.

Fonterra Milk in Schools will be finishing for us at the end of this year. Our Year 6 students do a great job of managing this in the mornings for those that want milk. We will be sorry to see it go but understand that it will be going to areas where the need is most. Their focus will be on Decile 1 to 5 schools supporting their Kickstart Breakfast programme and they will be partnering with NZ Food Network to distribute dairy products to charities, foodbanks and community partners.

Over the last three years our school roll has been dropping. We currently have 83 students and are predicted to start 2021 with 69 students. With less children we get less funding and the Ministry allocates us with less staff. We have had notification that we will be dropping a further teacher for 2021. Because of where the numbers fall in the classes and class sizes, the Board and Home and School have agreed to fund an extra teacher for the mornings four days a week. This will mean that our children will be getting good teacher support and taken regularly in their groups for literacy and mathematics. The Home and School will be looking for support with a big fundraiser next year. Please let the school know if you have any pre-schoolers that you expect will attend the school in the future and also if your child is leaving before Year 8, it is helpful for our planning Have a great week.
