The end of the school year is getting very close. Seniors have attended open days at their new high schools, they have had their last Technology session at Menzies yesterday and today the Year 8's are off to the "Tough Kids" competition

Last Friday the children took part in an exciting day of learning based around Enviroschools. Josh Sullivan, the Enviroschools educator, supported us to make this day happen. The children worked in their House Groups which meant that the older children could support the younger ones. I love seeing our older students taking on the role of guide and helper for our younger ones. They all got to make a Beeswax Wrap, weave a Harakeke flower, make a tukuku (Maori kite) using toitoi in a group and they made predator tracking stations to see what predators they have around their place. The children appreciate the help and support from our wider whanau at events like this and it was a great opportunity to work with the children in their classrooms. Thank you to those who came along and helped especially with the weaving and knot tying! The children learnt about the protocols around using harakeke (flax) and toitoi. The left overs were gathered up and returned to the base of the plants to help it to continue to thrive and grow. Once again I was very proud of their courtesy to those helping. patience and perseverance to complete the tasks. We finished the day in the crazy wind with planting some more native trees. These are going to be fantastic in a few years' time when they grow and the children can see that their efforts planting and looking after them will have paid off.

Our final Assembly will be held on Friday of next week. You are all welcome to come along to farewell Miss Georgia Taylor and any students leaving at the end of the year. We have all loved having Georgia work at Tokanui School and her smiling face will certainly be missed around the school by all of the students and staff. The staff got to celebrate Georgia's registration at a special ceremony last

week recognising that she has successfully completed her teacher training with the two years of practical work that she has done at Tokanui School. Congratulations Miss Taylor.
