Hello everyone

With the start of this week moving us back to Covid Level 2, it has been a reminder that we can't be too complacent and we need to keep up good hygiene practices and use the tracer app or sign in.

Moving forward, I would like you to be aware that we have a Covid Home Learning Plan should we end up back at Alert Level 3 or 4. We will be able to support families with access to devices and have home learning packs ready to go. Reading books and a book to write in would come home and children will have access to online readers. The first form of communication is the School App and ongoing sharing of learning and communication between home and school is through SeeSaw. Because we have the paid version of Seesaw we are lucky enough to be able to assign activities to individual children and keep track of what they have completed and it works well as a regular communication between home and school. Please let your child's teacher or the office know if you don't have access to either of these forms of communication. We can help you to get it set up or make alternative arrangements if that is not possible.

Unfortunately John Parsons has not been able to visit our children today to teach them about Cyber Safety due to the change in Covid Levels. I will keep you updated on when he will be down and I encourage all parents to attend to learn how to keep one step ahead of your children online.

All of the children have completed their 'Bottletop Art' and we look forward to seeing it at the Art Exhibition at Waikawa. They have some very creative ideas. This year we won't be visiting so do try to get along and have a look as I know that the children will love seeing their work on display.
