## A note from our Principal:

Kia ora everyone

What a wonderful day we had at the Southern Zone Athletics on Friday. Ascot School hosted us on their school grounds and with only the elite athletes attending from most schools, it was a much smaller group. Our students managed themselves well and gave it their best shot. Thank you to the support from parents/caregivers getting the children to the right place at the right time as our staff were kept busy all day at the High Jump. The following students qualified for Southland Athletics to be held at Surrey Park on Saturday 27th March:

Harry Barnes - 200m, Cammy Wright - discus, 200m and long jump, Deakin Weir - shot put and 100m, Imagen Earwaker - High Jump, Isobel Manson - 100m and 200m, Mackenzy Hansen - long jump, 100m, high jump, and discus, Manaia Hakaraia - shot put. Congratulations to these students and all the best at the Southland competition.

This week the children have Swimsafe every afternoon. This is taken by trained swim instructors and funding comes through REAP to support the programme. According to Water Safety NZ there have been 39 preventable drowning deaths within New Zealand in the year to date 19th June 2020. There were 40 in the previous year. The Swimsafe programme is to help to reduce these figures by giving our children the skills to keep themselves safe around and in the water. Thank you to Jillian Strang who has helped with the organisation of the children so that teachers can send children down in ability groups.

Kelly McGowan, from McDermott's transport was out last week to talk to some of the children about safe behaviour on the bus and why it is important. She left us with some handouts for all families around behaviour and responsibilities on the bus. Look out for these in children's bags.
