I love the autumn and Easter time and I am so pleased that we will get an Easter Break this year. I really missed it with our lockdown in 2020. Our students will get an extra long break with Thursday prior off as well while the teachers take part in Staff Development around our student's wellbeing. You may have seen the advertisements around Pause, Breath, Smile, a mindfulness programme supported by Southern Cross. This will help children to have the tools they need to achieve positive mind health. Nigel Latta is one well known expert that is behind this programme.

Pause, Breathe, Smile is about teaching our tamariki how to deal with stress and anxiety, manage their feelings and emotions and skills for living a less stressful and happier life.

Today we have the School Swimming Sports starting at 12:45. You are all welcome to come along and cheer on the children. Don't forget that on the last Thursday of term we have our Creative Connections morning. Parents/caregivers are welcome to come along and join in with the children while they take part in an art lesson. You can watch the children or have a go yourself. The two junior classes will be doing their art work from 9-10am and the senior classes from 10:30-12pm. The different times are to allow caregivers to visit children in different parts of the school over the morning. Join the staff for a quick cuppa at morning tea (hopefully Mad Cow Coffee will be onsite) and then at 12pm the House Chant Off will take place followed by the House Swimming Relays. Whanau are welcome to join in these events and stay on for the sausage sizzle at 12:30pm if you wish. Put your sausage orders in with your children.

We have some other events coming up over the next two terms where whanau can be involved also. We are working on a Marae visit and an Enviroschools Day and Local Histories Day at Slope Point.

Enjoy the Easter Break and we will see the children back at school next Wednesday.
