He panui na to maatau Tumuaki: A note from our Principal: Kia ora tatou

It is great to be back at school for the start of Term Two. There is a lot happening throughout the school this term.

The children have started their training for Cross Country so please send them along with suitable footwear to help with this. Children attending Deep Cove Camp need to be fit for walking up hills. Please support children training for this over the next month. On Thursdays the children eat their morning tea in their house groups. This helps with building relationships across the school and develops a supportive family environment. There will also be some friendly inter-house competition throughout the year. The children are all learning to "Pause, Breathe, Smile"; a New Zealand locally developed and researched mindfulness programme for children that will support their wellbeing and give them skills for life. This programme has been made available to schools by Southern Cross. Research shows that Pause, Breathe, Smile: Improves focus and attention, increases calmness, enhances self-awareness, improves conflict resolution skills, promotes pro-social behaviour and significantly increases wellbeing. The children responded well in their first lesson where they learnt about eating mindfully and focusing on their breathing while letting go of distractions and other things that may busy their minds. Look out for the notice that will give parents access to the programme and more information about it.

Remember that we have a Teacher's Only Day on Tuesday next week. This is part of the Community of Learning/Kahui Ako and staff will all be learning alongside others from our local schools. Don't forget Camo Day on Friday. The children love a dress up day and celebrating duck shooting by getting dressed up in their Camo gear is a fun day.

Next week we will be taking the whole school to Slope Point to learn about the native bush there and some local history. Caregivers should have received a notice about this asking for parent helpers on the day.

















