## Medical Centre continued.

We have had a lot of questions recently about the Primary Response In Medical injuries (PRIME) service offered in the region. The key objectives of PRIME is to provide a rapid response to critically ill or injured patients, and to provide higher level medical skills, if required working up to the level of intensive care paramedic within the legal medical scope of practice.Specially trained doctors and Nurses are employed for this role. The Clinical Nurse Specialist employed as the PRIME RESPONDER based from Tokanui Medical centre covers approximately 90 km of some of the remotest areas in new Zealand and is on call 24

# hours a day from Monday to Friday.

The PRIME service is currently NOT covered/funded for the weekend in this specific area
